



Dear St. Mary's University Music Students, Faculty and Staff,

Thank you again for supporting each other through our time of need. The best way for us to proceed is to communicate well, and take care of each other. We all have individual and collective goals that we have been planning for. However, we are not in an ideal situation. It is now for us to move forward collectively in a way that best serves everyone. We will lead by example and in service of others.

A few minutes ago, President Mengler informed the St. Mary's community of the following:

- "First, St. Mary's University has extended spring break by one week for students, through the week of Monday, March 16. The campus remains open, and faculty and staff will continue campus operations.
- Second, beginning the week of March 23, all St. Mary's University <u>classes will resume in a fully online format</u> for the remainder of the spring semester. Please watch for additional updates next week.
- Third, out of an abundance of caution and in keeping with the recommendations of government and health officials to limit crowd sizes and group gatherings, the University is in the process of canceling many campus events, including student activities and other academic events, planned on campus through April 30, 2020."
