

## OUR GOAL

Safely welcome all of our Tempe Elementary students into a healthy and engaging learning environment.

In-person learning is scheduled to begin on October 26, 2020 for kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd grade and 6th grade at middle schools, WTA and Laird & November 2, 2020 for 4th, 5th, 7th and 8th grade.\*

\*Parents will have the option to continue online learning for their child(ren). We are also continuously monitoring guidance from CDC, Arizona Department of Health Services, Arizona Department of Education & Governor Doug Ducey.

### TEACHER CONTACT

- Teachers will be in contact with their students daily.
- Teachers will conduct Google Meet small group sessions daily with select groups of students for varying subject areas.

 Phone calls will be made twice weekly if contact cannot be made over
 Google Meet or Google
 Classroom. Teachers will post student assignments and parent announcements weekly. A Google Classroom will be built for every grade level at every site.



### **TEACHER CONTACT CONT'D**

- Teachers will monitor
   Exact Path and Study
   Island progress.
- Teachers will provide progress reports and grades as regularly scheduled.

 Daily attendance will be monitored by the teachers as well as the technology support assistants.  Teachers will address social/emotional learning needs as identified and refer to counselors and social services for support as necessary.

## **ONLINE LEARNING**

- Students will have the option to continue 100% teacher led, virtual learning once in- ${\color{black}\bullet}$ person learning begins on October 26, 2020 and November 2, 2020.
- This is available to students in Kindergarten 8th Grade.  ${\color{black}\bullet}$
- Students will work from home on their District issued device five days per week for online instruction with their classroom teacher and on the Edmentum platforms of Exact Path (K-8) for Reading, Writing and Math and <u>Study Island</u> (3-8) for Social Studies and Science. The purpose of the platform is to provide independent practice at the student's unique level of skills and is not meant to replace teacher-led instruction.
- Students will have daily contact with their classroom teacher for whole group instruction. Individual and small group instruction will also take place remotely.
- Students will continue to be assigned a teacher at their regular school in order to stay connected, access resources, access social/emotional support, special activities, and to receive school communication.



## ONLINE LEARNING CONT'D



Google Classroom



- All students will access Exact Path, Study Island, Google Classroom and Google Meet through their Single Sign On.
- Assignments can be uploaded from Exact Path to Google Classroom.
- Exact Path and Study Island are available 24/7.
- Google sessions can be recorded and played back for students at any time through a link in Google Classroom.
- Students were placed in a learning path based on the NWEA score obtained in December of 2019 or placed at approximately their current grade level by Exact Path. Kindergarten & 1st grade will be placed at beginning of grade level.
- Paths of study can be adjusted by staff if the work becomes too easy or difficult.





## ONLINE LEARNING CONT'D

- We will continue to use the district-adopted curriculum to teach remotely.  $\bullet$
- We will continue to follow the district-adopted curriculum map in order to make sure that all grade level standards are taught.
- Exact Path and Study Island are not replacements for teacher-led instruction.  $\bullet$
- Exact Path and Study Island offer students the ability to practice independently.
- Exact Path offers Math, Reading, and ELA resources for grades K-8.
- Study Island offers Social Studies and Science resources for grades 3-8.  ${\color{black}\bullet}$
- Social Studies and Science resources will be provided by the Teaching and Learning Department for grades K-2.
- Students need to make daily contact with their teacher via phone, Google Classroom, Google Meet, Exact Path or Study Island to maintain enrollment.
- If students are ill or not participating, the parent or guardian shall call the school  $\bullet$ office and follow attendance procedures.

#### PACE (Gifted Program)

- Rosetta Stone can be continually accessed in order to expedite language acquisition.
- Structured English Immersion (SEI) Specialists will be delivering virtual instruction.

## SPECIAL EDUCATION

 Special Education students will receive special education services through virtual and/or in-person instruction or therapy depending on their IEP.  Special Education teachers will have weekly communication and feedback to the parent and student to provide progress updates.

- We will continue with our Second Step Social Emotional Curriculum with an added component for COVID-19, school closure, trauma, and isolation resources.
- In partnership with the City of Tempe, we will continue to have support from Care 7, Human Services, Thrive to Five, Triple P Parenting Support, as well as School Resource Officers and Youth Specialists at every middle school.
- The Tempe Impacts Education (TIE) Foundation, along with other generous partners, will continue to provide support with basic needs, clothing and food.

## NUTRITION

- FREE curbside breakfast and lunch from 7 a.m. 12 p.m. on school days for all children 18 and under. Getz School and Ward Traditional Academy will not be serving meals at their site location. Parents/guardians are encouraged to visit any other Tempe Elementary school for their meals. Meyer Montessori will be serving meals from 11 a.m. - 12 p.m.
- Students do not need to be present to pick up meals.
- Meals will be pre-packaged and self-contained.
