However, together we will be able to face these challenges with a strategic and comprehensive plan, that will ensure everyone's safety and still continue their quality education. It is important that we keep in communication, and plan for the future. Thank you for your continued commitment to our students.

Hopefully you all received the email from President Mengler about St. Mary's University's plan for readiness regarding COVID-19. If by chance you haven't, here are the details.

"To help ensure the health and safety of our campus community, St. Mary's University is extending spring break by one week for students. The campus remains open, and faculty and staff will continue campus operations. Classes will resume on Monday, March 23, 2020."

What this means for us in the Department of Music.

- As of this moment as I am writing this email, classes are scheduled to resume <u>on campus</u> on Monday March 23, 2020. That could change in the near future, so please stay in communication.
- During the extended Spring Break, we are tasked to train ourselves to be ready to give online only instruction.

 - o Spotify or youtube playlists o Listening assignments o Watch Parties
 - o Challenges "100 day practice challenge"
