Journal of the Plague Year is an online, digital archive built from materials submitted by the general population sharing their own experiences during this unique and challenging time. By gathering photographs, journals, news articles, firsthand accounts, etc. from a wide variety of people from unique walks of life, Journal of the Plague Year is creating a lasting resource for future generations and scholars to learn about, and reflect upon, this unique and trying time in our history from a wide range of perspectives, as expressed in real-time.

The collection #healthcareheroes is a collection based on firsthand accounts (images and stories) of healthcare workers during the COVID-19 pandemic. Its purpose is to provide primary source materials directly from healthcare professionals and facilities in order to contribute their voice to the archive in the most direct and unedited format possible.
